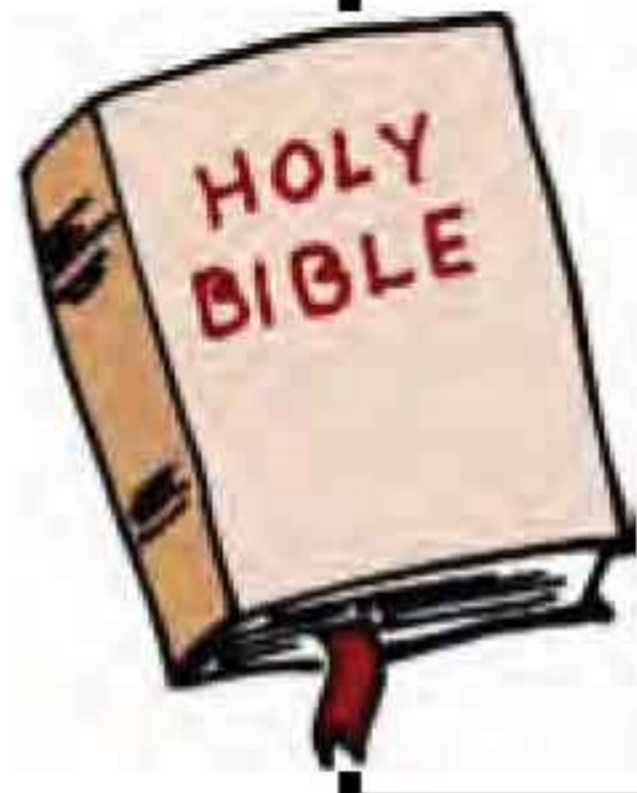

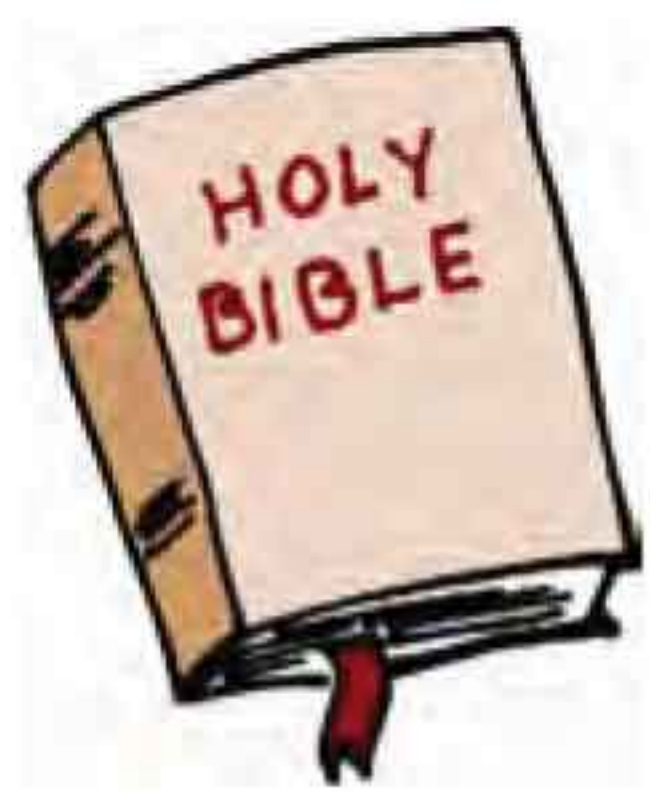


The Blessing for you

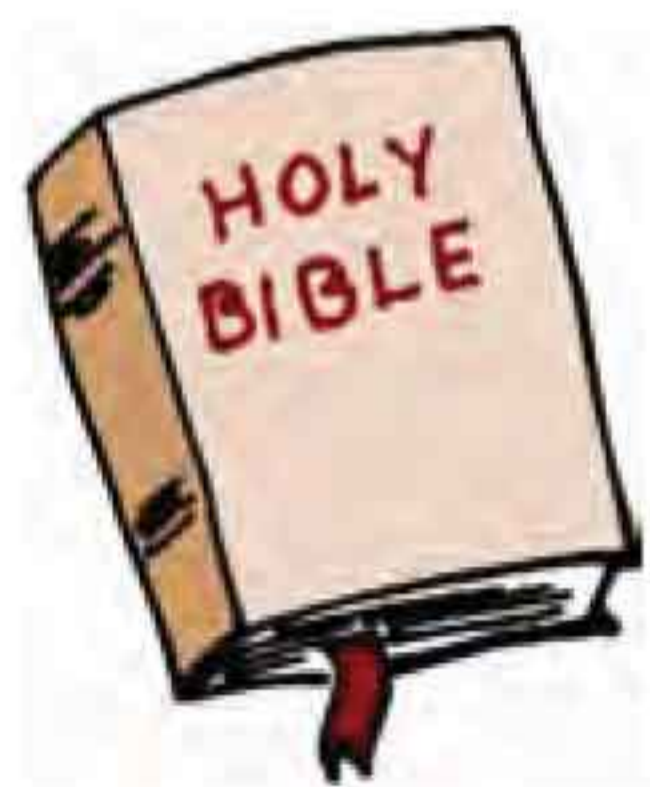

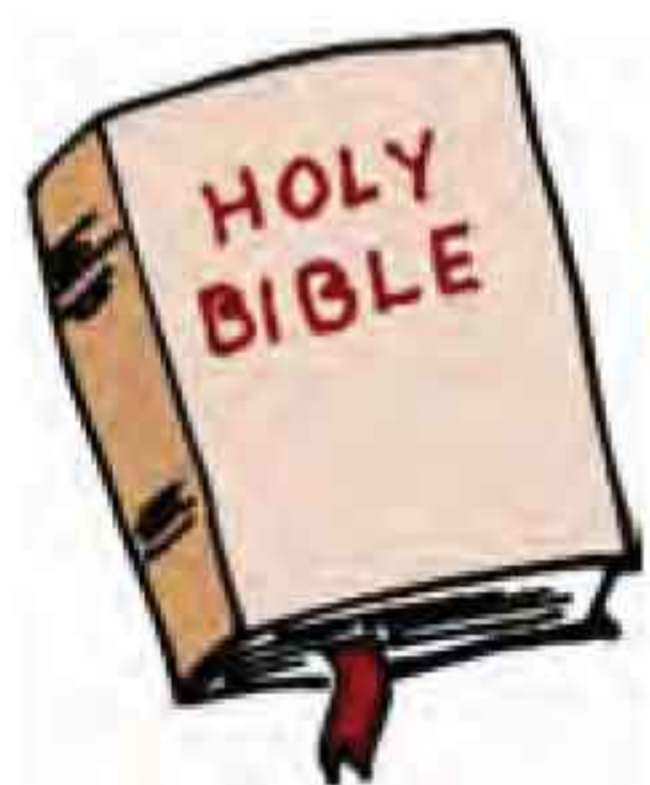
